GIFT SHOP VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!



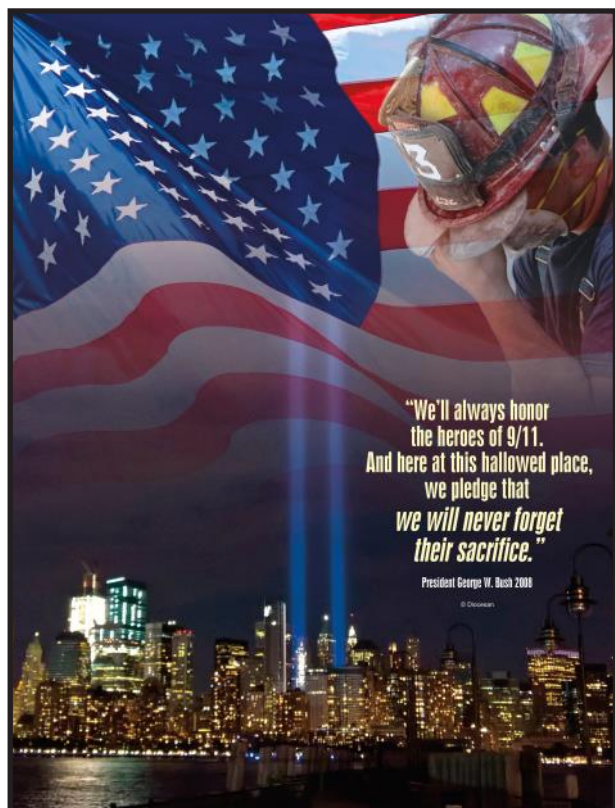
